Cartographie du Désastre is the first confrontation between two remarkable artists of the Latin-American scene: the Mexican **Teresa Margolles** and the Colombian **Oscar Muñoz**, who are joined by the Argentinian artist **Julieta Hanono**.

The exposition evokes, under differentiated forms—merging the intimate grief and the collective memory—a singular story of violence in the heart of Latin American societies. The drug-trafficking strains in the US-México border are evidenced through the

last pieces of the **Teresa Margolles'** series **Ciudad Juárez**. The evocation of key episodes of the political violence that destabilized the Colombian democracy is present in **Oscar Muñoz's** *Impresiones Débiles*. Finally, lacerating weights of the personal suffering linked with **Julieta Hanono's** torture and captivity in the course of the Argentinian dictatorship are evident in her work.

The exposition will open on Saturday, January 14th at 6:00 pm.
