Tierra en Trance is the first retrospective of the Argentinian artist **Marcos López** in France. His first black & white photographs will interact and dialogue with the emblematic creations of his “Pop Latino” period, as well as with other pieces made specifically for this exposition.

Tierra en Trance brings us back to this land, the Latin American one, to its founding myths, its fracture lines and its unlimited promise of a future. It acts like a mirror

deformed by its identity tensions; whether as an herald of its latin soul or a receptacle of its myths, spearhead of its “Pop Latino” revolution. Later, as a portraitist of a conquering “New World”, Marcos López habits these tensions using an infinite variety.

“Tierra en Trance” refers to a famous Glauber Rocha’s film, leader of the Brazilian New Wave that merges strongly political topics with mystic and folkloric elements.
